

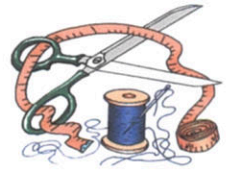
# After School Activities at STMA

## For Grades 3 – 8 (continued)



**Drama Club** – Drama Club works all year to choose, practice, and perform a Spring play. Meets every other \*Wednesday in the Fall, then every Wednesday after Christmas break, 3:30 – 4:30pm. \*Note: Meeting day has changed from last year.

## For Grades K – 2
